Slices of Wisdom. Episode 1



When I was young, in the new days of indomie craze. I was still in primary school. Every kid was talking about it, they brought it to school. Then macaroni and spaghetti came around and the focus changed. I and my sister were already tired of the noodles eating. We wanted something new. We wanted spaghetti and macaroni. We told our Father, he brought home a carton of macaroni the next time. Mum wasn't available to prepare it. 10 year old I decided to do it. I felt since I had already learnt to make noodles, this one wouldn't be different. I opened it; there was no spices sachet in it like the noodles. I thought that the spices might have hidden in the macaroni holes. So I prepared it like that, no salt, no seasoning. Poured it into the flask and we went off to school. Don't ask if we ate it. We poured it away. It was really bland and tasteless.

Let's pick out some lessons from the story above.

The problem there was that I lacked experience; I had never made macaroni before. The passion and eagerness to cook it didn't suffice for my lack of experience. Here's the thing.

No matter how passionate you are about the things you want to do. Spend some time to get experience about it. Let's say, you want to be a hair dresser, you really love to make hair and your passion is to make people beautiful. You put up a sign board advertising your services, after a couple of customers, no one comes again.

What happened? You may ask.

Your customers were not satisfied. You lacked the experience to give them what they want.

So imagine, you spent two years learning at a saloon. You will have passion and experience which can guarantee your success.

Here's the truth, for every new and different thing you want to do or a venture you want to undertake, you need to have the required capacity to have and sustain it. This capacity can be gotten by experience. Its experience that makes you an expert.

Let me show you a few life and success hacks.

1. Ask questions: there is a proverb in Igbo language which says, "onye ajuju anaghi efu uzo", he who asks questions doesn't miss his way. If I had asked, how can I

do this? I would have saved me and my sister the stress and hunger we had to experience. There were people around who knew how to prepare macaroni, but I didn't ask. There is a lot of knowledge to be acquired if only you'd learn to ask.

You can't figure out life on your own. Ask questions? How did you do this? How did you build your business? What are the mistakes you made? Asking someone this kind of question will encourage them to pour out their wealth of knowledge to you. Don't hold it back. Ask questions. Even if you know, you may get a different perspective which may be better than the one you knew.

2. Listen and learn from others: someone has been where you are and have travelled the road you want to travel. Instead of setting out, making mistakes and learning from them. You can ask those people who you know have passed through same things. Our neighbor always prepared macaroni, if I had asked her instead of relying on my own knowledge. I won't have wasted the food.

I didn't know it all, I learnt but that was after I had already wasted some of it.

Don't be like me. Ask questions, listen and learn. Learn from the mistakes of others, what they did and what they avoided. You can't go wrong if you do this.

3. Act: this is the most important of it all. Knowledge acquired needs to be acted on or it will be of no use. Practice on what you learn, it will make you perfect. Don't wait to know it all before you start. Just like the hair dresser example I gave, she won't have to know all styles at once. She can start using the ones she knowing and act on the knowledge she has gathered. Then gradually, she learns more. So can you, want to start a business, begin with the little knowledge you have already. Learn more as you go on every day. Success has a shortcut. Use it.
